## Mykolaiv National Agrarian University entered new level of international cooperation

Following ongoing negotiations throughout the summer, GC and MNAU sealed their strategic partnership by executing the TIASI participation and cooperation agreement in Mykolaiv on October 14 2024.

TIASI is an Innovation and Aerospace Supercluster Initiative which promotes collaboration between Canada, EU, Ukraine and MENA countries. It is a Canadian led international collaboration and investment platform (Meta Cluster) for the Canadian, Ukrainian and Hellenic and even though it is focusing on aerospace, marine industries, advance manufacturing and academic sectors, agro sector is the newest addition to its broad scope in innovation and R&D. MNAU with the Ukrainian, Canadian and EU stakeholder support and participation in TIASI will significantly increase growth in Canada, Ukraine, EU and globally as well increase direct foreign investment to MNAU & TIASI partners by participating in projects in the agro sector.

- 6. Systematic exchange of academic and professional staff and PhD students, post-doctoral students studying in partner institutions, engaged in research, in order to create agreed curricula and other mutually beneficial joint ventures.
- 7. Creation common Canadian Greek Ukrainian Innovation Technology Centre(s).
- 8. Participation in Erasmus programs
- 9. Opening joint Programmes for receiving scientific Degrees and academic positions
